### TONYA'S TOOLS

**Tegrity (lecture-capture)** allows me to teach the material to my online students as if I were standing in front of the students in a classroom setting. I now use these recordings for my TUG students.

**Discussion Boards** are used to promote student collaboration. Students are encouraged to present questions about the course and homework on the discussion board as opposed to sending me an email.

**Collaborate (web-conferencing)** is used for my office hours in the online environment. I was pleasantly surprised at how easy it was and how it truly allowed for a face to face conversation to occur as if they were sitting in my office.
